Job-based Internship Manual: Introduction Developed and Written by Dr. Judy Lee, July 2007

This information is provided for the Educational Media student who is eligible to enroll in EME 6946 Section 0063: Graduate Internship. A Job-based Internship is designed for students enrolled in the online Master of Education in Educational Media that are currently working in a pk-12 school library media center as the school library media specialist. It will be completed in the school library media center in which the student currently works.

In this type of Ed Media Internship, the UCF/College of Education Ed Media Faculty Supervisor and the Ed Media intern work together towards successful completion of the internship.

NOTE: When students demonstrate personal limitations that might impede future performance, or consciously violate ethical standards and/or ineffective and/or harmful behavior to students, they will not receive the UCF/COE supervisor's endorsement to continue the internship. Under such circumstances, the UCF/COE supervisor will review the internship process, discuss the situation with the intern and initiate dismissal from the internship and/or the Ed Media program Masters program.
